Graduation Requirements

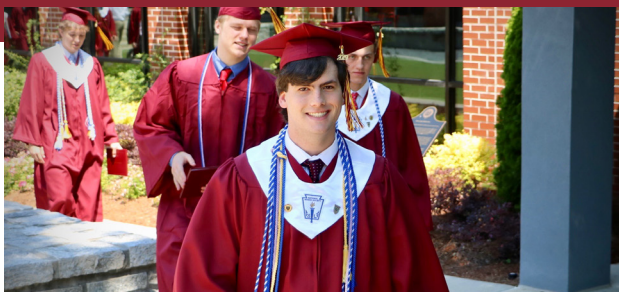
All students must be enrolled in seven classes per semester.
HIES graduation requirements are:

4 credits	English
4 credits	Math
3 credits	History, including United States History
4 credits	Lab Science
3 credits	Foreign Language <i>(all should be in the same language)</i>
3 credits	Religion
1 credit	Fine Arts
1 credit	Physical Education
2 credits	Electives <i>(electives include any courses beyond the requirements above)</i>

25 credits total

Students are required to complete 60 hours of community service (15 hours per school year). National Honor Society students are expected to complete 40 hours of community service each year.

HIES offers 27 Advanced Placement and 29 Honors classes, allowing students to explore interests and individualize their course of study.
